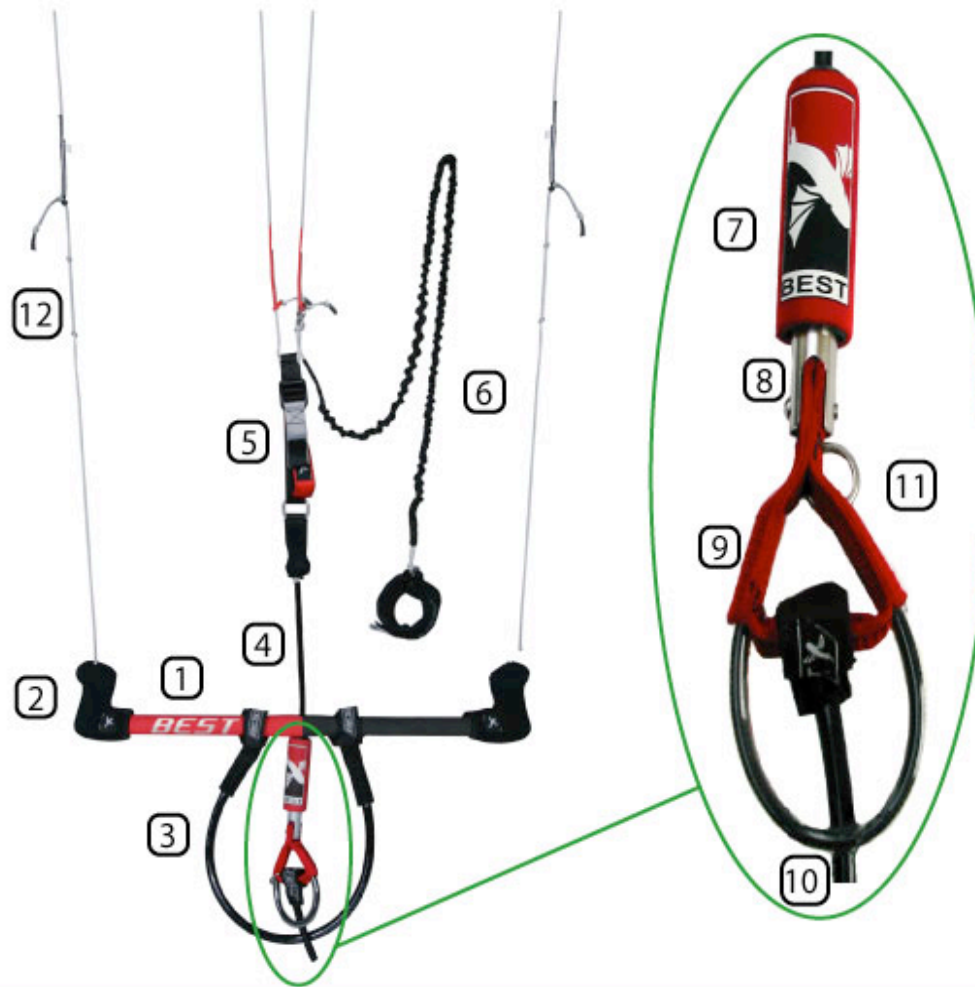

Best Carbon Bar

- ① Bar with EVA grip
- ② Neoprene cover
- ③ Harness line
- ④ Depower line
- ⑤ Power- depower strap
- ⑥ Safety hand leash
- ⑦ Grenade release grip
- ⑧ Release joint
- ⑨ Depower loop
- ⑩ Security tongue
- ⑪ Ring for handle pass leash
- ⑫ Leader lines



Two easy steps to open the  
Grenade Release System

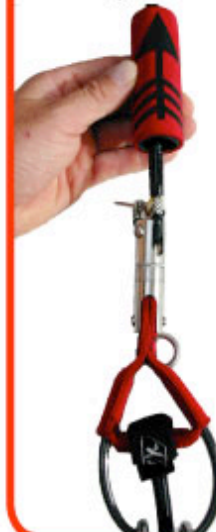
Closed system



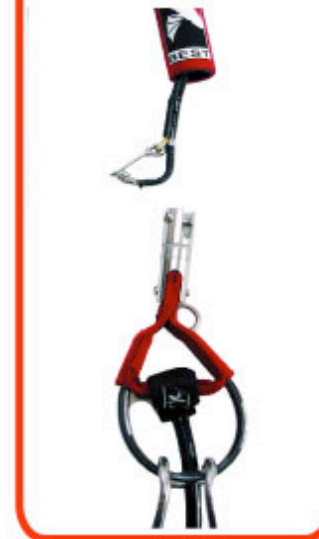
Step 1: grab the  
release grip



Step 2: move the  
release grip away  
from your body



Open system



Tip: Always keep the security tongue (10) inside the harness spreader bar to secure the depower loop (9) from falling out of the harness spreader bar (losing the loop).  
If you want to ride unhooked use the ring (11) for the handle pass leash to secure the depower loop.

Three easy steps to close the Grenade Release System

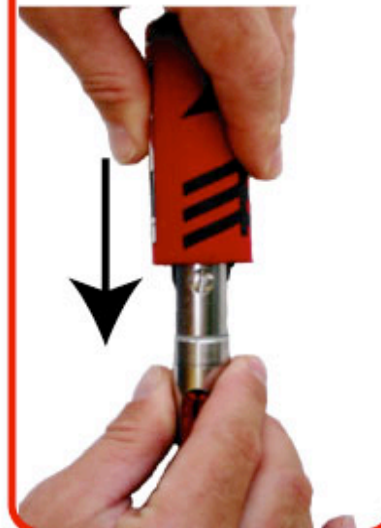
Step 1: mount the line through the release joint and slide the line with the loop over the pin.



Step 2: move the pin up to tubing on hold the pin.



Step 3: slide the release grip over the release joint.



**Important:** It is your responsibility to maintain the proper working order of the Grenade Release System. Always inspect the system prior to launching your kite. Before each session you should "half release" the release grip to ensure there is no sand or debris caught in the sliding mechanism to make sure the release slides easily. Make sure the release grip (7) is properly seated over the release joint (8), before you ride, and occasionally while on the water.
